



HEALTH SAFETY SECURITY AND ENVIRONMENT POLICY

Obligations

Airborne Petroleum Geophysics recognizes its moral and legal responsibility to provide a safe and healthy working environment for its employees, contractors and subcontractors. This responsibility extends to ensuring that the local community and the environment are not harmed by our operations.

Objectives

APG is committed to the safe and efficient operation of its aircraft and facilities with the goals of preventing all accidents, injuries and occupational illness and of protecting the environment.

In order to achieve this, APG will:

- Employ a fulltime Health, Safety, Security and Environment Officer and Safety Management System Administrator;
- Promote Health, Safety, Security, and Environment (HSSE) and Safety Management Systems in all its operations and manage it in the same way as any other critical business;
- Comply with all applicable laws and regulations and apply appropriate standards where regulations do not exist;
- Have a sound HSSE and Safety Management System in which competencies, responsibilities, and communication requirements are clearly defined;
- Provide a safe and healthy work environment for its employees and contractors with adequate facilities and protective equipment;
- Identify and analyze potential hazards and security threats and implement measures to avoid, prevent, control, and mitigate the associated risk;
- Be prepared for a quick and efficient response to emergency situations to minimize the potential impact of incidents should they occur;
- Maintain facilities and equipment, and to use services in such a way as to minimize risk to people and the environment;
- Provide training to its employees supported by internal standards, procedures, and instructions that are built into the design and planning of all aspects of its operation;
- Use energy and natural resources efficiently in preventing pollution and in promoting its employees' awareness in order to minimize adverse impact on the environment; and
- To set performance targets and goals so as to achieve continuous improvement and ensure compliance with all applicable regulations and standards.

Responsibilities

The responsibility for developing, maintaining and deploying this policy rests with the President of Airborne Petroleum Geophysics.

The responsibility for implementing this policy rests with all group line managers and employees, as well as contractors and subcontractors.

Employees and contractors will be bound to follow all HSSE and SMS policies and procedures and report known or observed hazards and/or incidents to their immediate supervisor.

Application of the Policy

This policy is applicable to Airborne Petroleum Geophysics and all of its related companies in their entire operations worldwide.
